

Handwork Quilt Block



A pattern by

Finished Size: 6 1/2 x 6 1/2



Materials Required

Brown Scrap Fabric	4 x 4 inches (x2)
Green Scrap Fabric	4 x 4 inches (x2)
White Scrap Fabric	4 x 4 inches (x2)
Multi-Colored Fabric	5 x 5 inches (x1)
6 x 6 Inch Square Ruler	Craft Iron
Fabric Pencil	Thread
Fabric Scissors	Quilt Pins
Copy of attached Template	– PRINT AT 100%

Cutting Instructions

PRINT TEMPLATE AT 100%

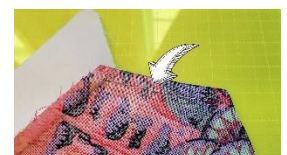
Cut out each individual template piece.

Place template on the **WRONG** side of each fabric. Trace the template pieces.

Cut **TWO EACH**: A = Brown Fabric
B = Green Fabric
C = White Fabric
Cut **ONE** of D = Multi Colored Fabric



- Using your 6 x 6 inch square ruler, measure 1/4 inch from the outside edge of your (D) Center fabric piece. Draw a line. Repeat this step for all sides of the octagon Center fabric piece making sure the line ends cross each other.
- Repeat step 1 by drawing 1/4 inch lines around all your remaining fabric pieces.
- Place one (C) White fabric piece and your (D) Center piece **Right Sides Together (RST)**. Line up the smaller edge of your White piece with one outside edge of the Center piece. Stitch **ON** your 1/4 inch line: *****START AND STOP your stitching in between the cross lines at each edge, as shown.***** Press seam **OPEN**.
- Keeping your White piece out of the way, repeat step 3 using one (B) Green fabric piece, lining it up on the Center piece edge directly to the **RIGHT** of the White piece, as shown in photo.
 - Stitch **ON** the line **IN BETWEEN THE CROSS LINES**. Press seam **OPEN**.
- Gently fold Center piece so that the White and Green pieces are **RST**. Line up the raw edges so the center cross point is centered. Place quilting pins to hold the fabrics in place. **SEE PHOTO**.
- Stitch **ON** the line **STOPPING JUST BEFORE THE CROSS LINES**. Press seam **OPEN**.
- Repeat Steps 1 – 6 using remaining fabric pieces working your way around the Center piece. Continuing on the **RIGHT**, place: (A) Brown fabric, (C) White fabric, (B) Green fabric, (A) Brown fabric. Press all seams **OPEN**.



Voila! You've just completed your Checklist Quilt Block!
