

Winter Table Quilts

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Start Here

I highly recommend reading through the instructions before you begin.

The pattern is separated into 3 parts. One to make the center Winter block, one to make the Table Runner and the third section to make ONE placemat.

All seams use a standard 1/4" allowance unless otherwise noted.
Binding fabric based on 2 1/2 inch x WOF cut strips.



Glossary:

WOF = Width of Fabric
RST = Right Sides Together
HST = Half Square Triangle

Winter Quilt Block

Finished Size: 10 1/2 x 10 1/2

Cutting Instructions

Fabric	QTY	Size
White	4	3 3/4 x 3 3/4
	8	1 1/2 x 3 1/2
	8	1 x 2 1/2
	4	1 1/2 x 1 1/2
Red	4	1 1/2 x 3 1/2
Green	8	1 x 2 1/2
	12	1 1/2 x 1 1/2
Black	4	1 1/2 x 4 1/2
Silver	4	1 1/4 x 5

Making the Winter Block

- 1) Draw a line on the **WRONG** side of one White 3 3/4 x 3 3/4 square across the diagonal, as shown. Cut **ON** the line.
- 2) Place one White triangle and one Silver 1 1/4 x 5 strip RST, as shown. Stitch along the long side. Press seam open.
- 3) Place second White triangle on the opposite side of Silver strip, RST. Stitch along long side. Press seam open.
- 4) Using a square ruler, trim your block to 3 1/2 x 3 1/2.
- 5) Repeat steps 1 – 4 to complete a total of **FOUR** Stripe Units.
