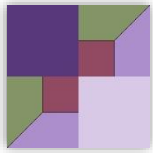


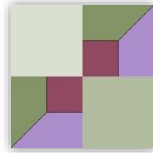
Charming Spiral Quilt

Week Four



Y-Seam Blocks

Full Block size: $8\frac{1}{2} \times 8\frac{1}{2}$ Unfinished
 *All seams are a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " unless otherwise stated



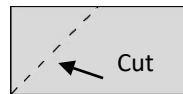
Materials Required:

Lilac	5	$2\frac{1}{2} \times \text{WOF}$
Dark Green	5	$2\frac{1}{2} \times \text{WOF}$
Various Fabric	40	$2\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$
	40	$4\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$ *
*Trim Squares if using Charm Pack		

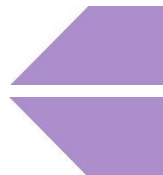
Cutting Instructions

- Cut Lilac $2\frac{1}{2} \times \text{WOF}$ to make FORTY (40) Lilac $5 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ units.
- Cut Dark Green $2\frac{1}{2} \times \text{WOF}$ to make FORTY (40) Green $5 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ units.

1) Draw a 45-degree diagonal line on the WRONG side of TWO Lilac $5 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ strip, as shown.



2) Place ONE Lilac $5 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ strip and Second Lilac $5 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ strip RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER.

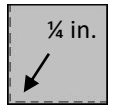


3) Cut ON your drawn line to create 2 opposite Trapezoids, as shown.

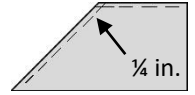
4) Repeat steps 1 – 3 with Two Dark Green $5 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ units.



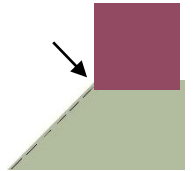
5) Using your ruler, draw a line around the edges of one Various Fabric $2\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ square $\frac{1}{4}$ inch from the edge, as shown.



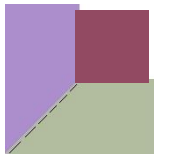
6) Using your ruler, draw a line around the edges of one Lilac and one Dark Green Right Trapezoid, $\frac{1}{4}$ inch from the edge, as shown.



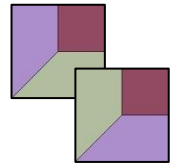
7) Line up the cross points of your drawn lines on one Dark Green Trapezoid with one Various Fabric $2\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ square, as shown. Press seam OPEN.



8) Line up the cross points of your drawn lines on one Lilac Left Trapezoid with the second side of the Various Fabric square so that the Lilac and Dark Green sides match up, as shown. Press seam OPEN.

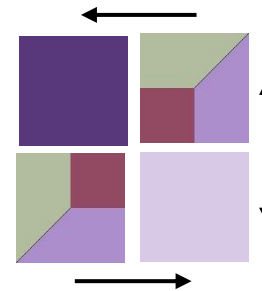


9) Place the Dark Green and Lilac edges Right Sides Together and stitch. Press seam open.



10) Trim Y-Seam corner to $4\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$ inch square.

11) Repeat steps 5 – 10 to create a total of TWO (2) Y-Seam corners.



12) Stitch together Y-Seam corners with TWO (2) Various Fabrics $4\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$ squares in rows as shown. Press all seams in the directions shown.

13) Repeat Steps 1 – 12 to make a Total of TWENTY (20) Y-Seam Blocks.
