DAY 1

- After we arrive at Edinburgh International Airport we'll take a scenic drive to Paisley, Scotland to visit the gorgeous Paisley Abbey.
- Next we're off to visit the Paisley Thread Mill and Sma'Shot Cottages to learn about how textiles were made.
- Then check in to your hotel and have a little rest before your welcome dinner.



DAY 2

- Day 2 begins by taking a scenic drive to the Auchindrain Historic Township for a step back in time!
- After the festival we'll take a scenic drive through the beautiful Glencoe as we work our way up to Fort William with a stop at the Ben Nevis Distillery for a wee dram!

DAY 3

- Jump back in the bus for a trip out for a visit with the famed Highland Coos and Sheep at the Blacksheep Adventures.
- Next, we'll learn about the great Jacobite uprising as you walk through the most photographed castle in the world - Castle Eilean Donan!
- Finally, we'll head out to the beautiful Isle of Skye!

DAY 4

- Day 4 has us traveling around Skye! We begin with a visit to the fabulous Sky Weavers - pedal powered loom
- Next, we'll visit our 2nd castle Dunvegan Castle
- Finally, we head up to visit Skyeskyns Sheepskins
 Tannery and enjoy Free time in Portree!









- Then we make our way up to the Culloden battlefield where you'll be guided through the harrowing events that took place there.
- Continuing on our Inverness tour you'll get a behind the scenes look at how tartans are made at the Scottish Kiltmaker Visitors Center.

DAY 6

- Today, you're in for the experience of a lifetime! We start with a boat ride on the Jacobite down Loch Ness. Be on the lookout for Nessie!!
- Next we get dropped off at the Urquhart Castle (castle #3!) with plenty of time to explore!
- After lunch we head back to Inverness for the Inverness Castle Experience! The city has transformed the entire castle into an immersive look at Scotland like you've never seen. INCLUDING the new Great Tapestry of the Highlands!

DAY 7

- Today you'll take a very scenic route through the Cairngorm National Park with a couple stops for photos and short walks.
- Along the way we'll take a tour through Blair
 Castle (#4) and Gardens with an optional Whisky
 Tasting and Distillery Tour.
- Next will be a visit to Black Watch Castle (#5).
- Rounding out the night we'll arrive in Edinburgh for a workshop with Tracy Perks!







- Today you'll enjoy guided tours through the Edinburgh Castle (#6) and the Palace of Holyrood.
- Then, you'll get to visit Dovecot Studios to learn about the art school and how those giant tapestries are made.
- Afterward you'll get to enjoy a free afternoon/evening to explore Edinburgh with an optional trip to Edinburgh Fabrics Quilt Shop!

DAY 9

- Heading outside the city we visit the Falkirk Wheel and gorgeous Kelpies statues.
- Next, you'll get to explore Doune Castle (#7) filming location for both Monty Python's "Hunt for the Holy Grail" and Starz's "Outlander"!
- Then we head to our 8th Castle Stirling Castle! You'll want to make sure there's plenty of space on your camera for this one!







- Then get lost in the ultimate history of Scotland told through the handwork of over 1000 Stitchers at the Great Tapestry of Scotland!
- Finally, we head back to Edinburgh for another workshop with Tracy Perks and an amazing farewell dinner.



 Today we head back to Edinburgh International airport to say our final goodbyes, exchange contact information and fly home with friendships and memories to last a lifetime!
